- 6. The permit holder must record the number of redfin taken pursuant to this notice in a register to be maintained at the registered fish farm, which must be made available for inspection by a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer upon request.
- 7. The permit holder must not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under the Act, except where specifically permitted by this permit.
- 8. The permit holder must at all times permit the Director of Fisheries, his employees, agents or contractors or any employees, agents or contractors of the Crown to enter the site for the purposes of inspecting the site and the permitted activities.

- 5. The fish farmer shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under the Act, except where specifically permitted by this notice.
- 6. The fish farmer must retain the copy of this permit which has been supplied by the Director of Fisheries, and if requested by a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer, produce that permit for inspection.
