REQUEST FOR TENDER

Miscellaneous Fishery Licences for Access to the Scallop Fishery

THE Director of Fisheries invites suitable applicants to make application under the Scheme of Management (Miscellaneous Fishery) Regulations 1984 for a Miscellaneous Fishery Licence to take scallop by diving in South Australian waters. One licence will be issued subject to the conditions of tender specified in the above regulations.

Applicants to the previous tender call should examine the revised request for tender and are invited to resubmit a tender under this call.

Under the revised provisions, the Miscellaneous Fishery Licence for the scallop fishery can be operated by a person (a registered master) other than the licence holder, the owner operator provision will not apply. A Miscellaneous Fishery Licence is issued for a 12 month period, is subject to annual renewal as provided for under the Fisheries Act 1982 and is a non-transferable entitlement.

Tenders must provide the following information and deposit as part of the requirements under the above regulations:

- Name, age, address and contact numbers of the person making application for the licence;

- Each tender is to be accompanied by a cheque equal to ten per cent of the amount tendered.

The tenderer must not have been convicted of a fisheries related offence in any State or Territory of the Commonwealth in the three years preceding their application.

PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture require tenderers to demonstrate an integrated approach to harvesting, processing and marketing of scallops to the required standard:

- Experience of the applicant in the fishing industry and/or food industries;
- Intended area of fishing operations; and
- Intended place of processing or sale of scallops.

Responses addressing the request for tender must be forwarded in a sealed envelope marked 'Scallop Tender' to the Director of Fisheries, G.P.O. Box 1671, Adelaide, S.A. 5001 by 4 p.m. on 3 September 1999. Tenders may also be delivered to the PIRSA tender box located on 14th Floor, Grenfell Centre, 25 Grenfell Street, Adelaide, S.A. 5000.
