FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Murray Williams, CMB Box 29, Corny Point, S.A. 5575 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permit holder'), is exempt from the provisions of the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the permit holder may possess Southern Rock Lobster (*Jasus edwardsii*) (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1 from 24 December 1999 until 27 December 1999.

SCHEDULE 1

1. All Southern Rock Lobster (*Jasus edwardsii*) possessed pursuant to this notice may only be stored on the registered boat M064, *Sea Fury*.
2. Only Southern Rock Lobster (*Jasus edwardsii*) caught pursuant to Northern Zone Rock Lobster Fishery Licence No. N099 may be possessed pursuant to this notice.
3. The permit holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
4. While engaging in the permitted activity, the permit holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Office if such an office requests that it be produced.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, those persons who hold a licence pursuant to the Scheme of Management (River Fishery) Regulations 1991 (hereinafter referred to as the 'fisher') are exempt from section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the fisher may take fish for trade or business using a set net with a mesh size greater than 15 cm (large mesh set net) and may use more than five large mesh set nets at any one time and may leave large mesh set nets in the water for a period comprised of more than four consecutive hours (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions outlined in Schedule 1 from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2000.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The fisher must use no more than 30 large mesh set nets at any one time.
2. The fisher must not leave large mesh set nets in the water for a period comprised of more than 24 consecutive hours.
3. The fisher shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
