FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, J. Rother and C. D. Allport, P.O. Box 1214, Victor Harbor, S.A. 5211 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permit holders'), are exempt from regulation 33 of the Fisheries (Exotic Fish, Fish Farming and Fish Diseases) Regulations 1984, subject to the conditions contained in Schedule 1, in that they shall not be guilty of an offence when bringing no more than 400 live yabbies (*Cherax destructor*) into the State without the appropriate disease free certification (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity').

SCHEDULE 1

1. The permit holder may engage in the permitted activity from the date of gazettal of this notice until 28 February 1999.
2. All fish taken pursuant to this notice must be relocated to registered aquaculture sites FT00042 or FT00588.
3. Any containers or receptacles used to import live fish pursuant to this notice must be treated in a manner prescribed in the regulations or as determined by the Director of Fisheries, in particular with chlorination, immediately upon delivery and removal of the live fish.

4. All liquid used to transport the live fish must be treated in a manner prescribed in the regulations or as determined by the Director of Fisheries, in particular with chlorination, immediately upon delivery and removal of the live fish.

5. While engaged in the permitted activity the permit holders must:

- (a) have in their possession the copy of this notice with which the Director of Fisheries has supplied them; and
- (b) produce that notice to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer forthwith, if and when a Compliance Officer requests them to produce it.

6. The permit holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
