FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that subject to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, those holders of a licence issued pursuant to the Scheme of Management (Abalone Fisheries) Regulations 1991 (hereinafter referred to as the 'fishers') are exempted from the provisions of regulation 19 (1) of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1984 and from regulation 10 (1) and regulation 12 (2) of the Scheme of Management (Abalone Fisheries) Regulations 1991 in that the fishers shall not be guilty of an offence when using a boat registered by endorsement on a fishery licence, pursuant to Division 1, Part 4 of the Fisheries Act 1982 for recreational fishing (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity'), subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2000.

SCHEDULE 1

- 1. The fishers must notify the PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Unit via Link Communications on 1800 244 166 prior to engaging in the permitted activity with the following information:
 - the commercial boat registration number and the fishery licence number to which the call applies;
 - the name of the person making the call (must be licence holder or a registered master) and the abalone fishery licence number:
 - the recreational registration numbers which will be placed on the boat;
 - the time and date recreation use will commence; and
 - the time and date recreation use will cease.
- 2. The fishers shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any other regulations made under that Act except where specifically exempted by this notice.
- 3. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity the fishers must have in their possession a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a Fisheries Compliance Officer.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that, pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Australian Bluefin Pty Ltd, 1 North Quay Boulevard, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5606, (hereinafter referred to as the 'permit holder'), the holder of a Marine Finfish Farming Licence FB00012, engaged in the farming of Southern Bluefin Tuna are exempt from licence conditions 2 and 2a but only insofar as they may allow the taking of those fish specified in Schedule 1 subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') for the purpose of trade or business from the waters endorsed on their Marine Finfish Farming Licence

SCHEDULE 2

- 1. The licence holder may only engage in the permitted activity until 30 June 1999.
- 2. The permitted activity must be conducted by D. Edmonds, 24 Duncan Avenue, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5606, holder of Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence number M035. Whilst conducting the permitted activity, D. Edmonds must use a registered vessel that is endorsed on his Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence.
- 3. Fish taken during the permitted activity may only be taken using devices that are endorsed on the marine scalefish fishery licence held by the operator.
- 4. The permit holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulation made under the Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
- 5. While engaged in the permitted activity the permit holder shall carry or have about or near his person a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer upon request.
