FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Thornhill Pty Ltd, 86 Ocean Avenue, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5606 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permit holder') is exempt from the notice made under section 43 of the Fisheries Act 1982, prohibiting the taking of Western King Prawns (*Penaeus latisulcatus*) in the waters of Spencer Gulf, in that the permit holder shall not be guilty of an offence when using a prawn trawl net for the purpose of gear trials (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions contained in Schedule 1 from 1 November 1999 to 5 November 1999 (inclusive).

SCHEDULE 1

1. The permit holder may use a prawn trawl net, the cod ends of which may be closed during the permitted activity in the permitted trial areas.

2. The permit holder may only conduct the permitted activity between the hours of 0700 and 1800 on the days for which this permit is valid.

3. The permitted holder may only engage in the permitted activity using the boat *Sandy S* endorsed on commercial fishery licence No. P24.

4. Any fish taken during the permitted activity are to be returned to the water immediately.

5. The permit holder may only engage in the permitted activity if a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer is on board.

6. The permit holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Nora Davies, 17 Highview Drive, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5606 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permit holder') is exempt from the notice made under section 43 of the Fisheries Act 1982 prohibiting the taking of Western King Prawns (*Penaeus latisulcatus*) in the waters of Spencer Gulf, in that the permit holder shall not be guilty of an offence when using a prawn trawl net for the purpose of gear trials (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions contained in Schedule 1 from 1 November 1999 to 5 November 1999 (inclusive).

SCHEDULE 1

1. The permit holder may use a prawn trawl net, the cod ends of which may be closed during the permitted activity in the permitted trial areas.

2. The permit holder may only conduct the permitted activity between the hours of 0700 and 1800 on the days for which this permit is valid.

4. Any fish taken during the permitted activity are to be returned to the water immediately.

5. The permit holder may only engage in the permitted activity if a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer is on board.

6. The permit holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, the holder of a prawn fishery licence issued pursuant to the Scheme of Management (Prawn Fisheries) Regulations 1991 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permit holder') is exempt from notices made under section 43 of the Fisheries Act 1982 prohibiting the taking of Western King Prawns (*Penaeus latisulcatus*) in the waters specified in Schedule 1, in that the permit holder shall not be guilty of an offence when using prawn trawl nets in accordance with the conditions of their fishery licence for the purpose of gear trials (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions contained in Schedule 2.

SCHEDULE 2

1. The permit is valid from 1 November 1999 to 31 October 2000.

2. The cod end of each prawn trawl net must remain open during the permitted activity.

3. The permit holder may only conduct the permitted activity between 0800 hours and 1700 hours.

4. The permit holder may only engage in the permitted activity in those waters of Spencer Gulf or Gulf St Vincent greater than 10 m in depth.

5. Any fish taken during the permitted activity are to be returned to the water immediately.

6. While engaged in the permitted activity, the permit holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.

7. The permit holder must contact the local Fisheries Compliance Officer or the Compliance Unit of PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture on 1800 065 522 not less than one hour prior to departure from port and provide them with the following information:

- (a) a description of the vessel to be used along with any registration number marked on that vessel;
- (b) the estimated time of departure from port;
- (c) the area in which the gear trials are to be conducted; and
- (d) the estimated time of return to port.

8. The permit holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, except whereby specifically exempted by this notice.
