FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Dennis Cawthorne or their registered master (hereinafter referred to as the 'fisher'), 141 Lighthouse Road, Port Macdonnell, S.A. 5291, is exempt from the provisions of licence condition No. 41 subject to the conditions set out in the schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

1. The fisher shall use no more than 48 pots in addition to the number of rock lobster pots currently endorsed on fishery licence S029, the maximum being 133 rock lobster pots in total until 15 March 2000.

2. No fee shall be payable by the fisher in respect to the rock lobster pots being used in addition to the number of rock lobster pots currently endorsed on the fishery licence.

3. Rock lobster taken from the additional 48 pots must be recorded on a SZRL1 form for fishery licence S031 (P. Cawthorne) and not included on the SZRL1 form for fishery licence S029.

4. The fisher shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any Regulation made under that Act or any condition of her licence, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

5. While engaged in the permitted activity the fisher shall have in their possession a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
