FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, David Warland or his agents (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') of South Australian Seahorse Services, P.O. Box 2236, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5606, is exempt from the Fisheries Act 1982 but only insofar as the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when taking and possessing 2 egg-bearing male and 2 female weedy seadragon (*Phyllopteryx taeniolatus*) (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity') subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, from South Australian coastal marine waters from the date of this notice until 31 August 2002.

SCHEDULE 1

- 1. All seahorses taken pursuant to this notice are for broodstock only and may not be sold or traded without written consent from the Director of Fisheries.
- 2. Seadragons of the same sex must not be collected within 5 km of each other.
- 3. The exemption holder shall provide a written report with details of each collection trip to the Director of Fisheries at the completion of the exempted activity.

- 4. At least 24 hours prior to engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder must contact the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with the following information:
 - the name of the person who will be conducting the exempted activity;
 - the intended location for conducting the exempted activity;
 - · the method of conducting the exempted activity; and
 - if using a boat to conduct the exempted activity, the description of the boat and the intended area of launching and retrieval.
- 5. Whilst engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
- 6. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
