#### FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Richard Mezic (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), c/o P.O. Box 472, North Adelaide, S.A. 5006, is exempt from the provisions of section 34 of the Fisheries Act 1982 but only insofar as the exemption holder shall use no more than 30 fish traps to take slipper lobster (*Ibacus peronii*) for trade or business (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 1, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 15 February 2002, unless varied or revoked earlier.

#### SCHEDULE 1

1. The fish traps must have a tag attached to the buoy that is marked with the name and address of the exemption holder.

2. All fish other than slipper lobster (*Ibacus peronii*) must be returned to the water immediately.

3. The exempted activity may only be undertaken in the waters of Spencer Gulf north of  $33^{\circ}50$ 'S.

4. Whilst conducting the exempted activity, the exemption holder must only use a boat that is endorsed on Spencer Gulf Prawn Fishery Licence No. P25 or another boat that is marked TP25.

5. PIRSA Fisheries retain the right for a departmental officer to accompany the exemption holder at any time during the exempted activity.

6. The exemption holder must provide a report in writing detailing the daily catch of slipper lobster and other species pursuant to this notice to the Director of Fisheries, (Attention: Roger Hill, G.P.O. Box 1625, Adelaide, S.A. 5001) within 14 days of the expiry of this notice.

7. While engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder shall have in their possession a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.

8. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any Regulation made under that Act or any condition of the licence, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
