FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Dr Michael Geddes or persons acting as his agents (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') from the Department of Environmental Biology, University of Adelaide, North Terrace, Adelaide, S.A. 5000, is exempt from the provisions of Clause 65 of Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 2000 to engage in the activities specified in Schedule 1 (herein-after referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 2 for 5 March and 6 March 2002 inclusive.

SCHEDULE 1

The collection of marine organisms from all waters of South Australia, including intertidal 'rocky' reefs (not including aquatic reserves).

SCHEDULE 2

1. The specimens collected by the exemption holder are for scientific purposes only and may not be sold.

2. Collections undertaken from intertidal 'rocky' reef areas must be undertaken with due consideration of other members of the public already in the area.

3. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must advise PIRSA Fisheries on 1800 065 522 with details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.

4. The exemption holder may not conduct any other activity whilst undertaking the exempted activity.

5. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice and must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced. 6. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to Section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Kym Peters (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), Lot 34 Leake Street, South End, S.A. 5280 is exempt from sections 34 and 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the exemption holder may take fish for the purpose of trade or business with mesh nets from the waters of Lake George (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in the schedule from 8 March 2002 until 12 March 2002, unless varied or revoked earlier.

SCHEDULE

1. The exemption holder must be accompanied by an officer from SARDI at all times whilst conducting the exempted activity.

2. Within 14 days of the expiry of this notice, the exemption holder must provide a report in writing to the Director of Fisheries, (Attention: Sean Sloan, GPO Box 1625, Adelaide, S.A. 5001), giving the date and time of collection and the name and weights of each species taken and sold.

3. The exemption holder shall notify the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 prior to conducting the exempted activity with the following information:

 details of the boat that will be used to engage in the exempted activity; and • the intended place and time of launching and retrieval of the nominated boat for that day.

4. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act or any condition of this notice, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

5. While engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder shall have in his possession a copy of this notice and such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 43

TAKE notice that, pursuant to the Fisheries Act 1982, it is hereby declared that it shall be unlawful for any persons, other than persons assisting in PIRSA approved research activities, to engage in the act or an act preparatory to or involved in the taking of fish from those waters specified in the schedule from 5 March 2002 until 30 December 2002, unless varied or revoked earlier by the Director of Fisheries.

All the waters of Lake George situated in the Hundreds of Lake George and Rivoli Bay.
