FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Tony Lee (the 'exemption holder'), P.O. Box 242, Mount Gambier, S.A. 5290 is exempt from section 34 of the Fisheries Act 1982 but only insofar as the exemption holder may take turbo (*Turbo undulatis*) for the purpose of trade or business from South Australian coastal waters (the 'exempted activity') subject to the conditions in Schedule 1 from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2005, unless revoked or varied earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The exemption holder may only take turbo (*Turbo undulatis*) by diving and collection by hand.
2. The exemption holder may take no more than 1 000 kg of Turbo (*Turbo undulatis*) in any one calendar month.
3. The exemption holder must provide the Director of Fisheries with separate statistical catch and effort information, in the form of a daily log as provided by the Director. The exemption holder must fill out the log every day and send a completed monthly log to the Director no later than the fifteenth day of the following month to the address specified.

4. The exemption holder must notify PIRSA Fishwatch on 1800 065 522 at least 24 hours prior to conducting the exempted activity and answer a series of questions about the exempted activity. The exemption holder will need to have a copy of the exemption notice at the time of making the call, and be able to provide information about the area and time of the exempted activity, the vehicles and boats involved, the number of agents undertaking the exempted activity and other related questions.

5. The exemption holder must allow a departmental officer to accompany the exemption holder at any time during fishing operations.

6. While engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder must carry or have about or near his person a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Officer upon request.

7. The exemption holder must not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
