TRADE STANDARDS ACT 1979

Declaration of Dangerous Goods

TAKE notice that I, Gail Gago, Minister for Consumer Affairs, declare that the goods specified in the Schedule are dangerous goods pursuant to section 25 (1) (a) of the Trade Standards Act 1979. Further, pursuant to section 25 (2) (a) and (b) of the Trade Standards Act 1979, I am satisfied that this declaration is necessary in order to avert serious risk of injury or impairment to health, and that it is not appropriate in the circumstances to deal with the matter by the prescription of safety standards.

On publication of this notice, no person shall, in the course of trade or business, manufacture, supply or sell items referred to in the Schedule, FORTHWITH.

SCHEDULE

Hand-held novelty items and toys, incorporating what is commonly known as a laser pointer, that are designed or adapted to emit a laser beam with an accessible emission level of greater than 1 milliwatt.
