1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Administrative Arrangements (Committal of Acts) Proclamation 2013*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Committal of Acts

The administration of an Act referred to in Schedule 1 is committed to the Minister for Industrial Relations

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Administrative Arrangements (Dissolution of Minister for Workers Rehabilitation as Body Corporate) Proclamation 2013*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Dissolution of body corporate

The Minister for Workers Rehabilitation is dissolved as a body corporate.

4—Vesting of certain assets, rights and liabilities

The assets, rights and liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Workers Rehabilitation are vested in and attached to the Minister for Industrial Relations.

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *Administrative Arrangements (References to Minister for Workers Rehabilitation) Proclamation 2013*.

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Interpretative provision

A reference to the Minister for Workers Rehabilitation—

- (a) in a statutory instrument under the *WorkCover Corporation Act 1994* or the *Workers Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 1986*; or
- (b) in a contract, agreement or other document made or entered into under or in connection with either of those Acts before the date on which this proclamation is made,

will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister for Industrial Relations.
