## DEVELOPMENT ACT 1993

### ALTERATION TO THE BUILDING CODE OF AUSTRALIA

#### *Preamble*

1. The Building Code of Australia being Volumes One and Two in the National Construction Code series as in force from time to time is adopted by the Development Regulations 2008 as part of the Building Rules under the Development Act 1993.

2. The Building Code of Australia is altered annually for national adoption on 1 May each year.

3. The Development Act 1993 requires that notice of the alteration must be published before the alteration can take effect.

#### NOTICE

PURSUANT to Section 4 (7) of the Development Act 1993, notice is given of an alteration to the 2013 edition of the Building Code of Australia being Volumes One and Two in the National Construction Code series. The Code has been amended and republished as BCA 2014 by the Australian Building Codes Board.

BCA 2014, as modified by the variations and additions for South Australia contained in the Appendix to that Code, will take effect for the purposes of the Development Act 1993 on 1 May 2014, with the following exceptions:

- (a) Clauses BP1.4 and B1.6 of Volume One; and
- (b) Clause P2.1.2 and Part 3.10.3 of Volume Two; and
- (c) Clause 3.9.1.3 (g) of Volume Two is replaced with:

3.9.1.3 (g) Treads must have a slip resistant finish or a suitable non-skid strip near the edge of the nosings.

## DISABILITY SERVICES (ASSESSMENT OF RELEVANT HISTORY) REGULATIONS 2014

### *Authorised Screening Unit*

REGULATION 5 (1) of the Disability Services (Assessment of Relevant History) Regulations 2014 provides for the Chief Executive to establish authorised screening units or declare by notice in the Gazette that a person or body is an authorised screening unit. Regulation 5 (1) provides:

#### *5—Screening units*

(1) The Chief Executive may, as the Chief Executive thinks fit—

- (a) establish authorised screening units; or
- (b) declare, by notice in the *Gazette*, that a person or body is an authorised screening unit,

for the purposes of undertaking relevant history assessments under Section 5B and 5C of the Act.

Pursuant to the Disability Services (Assessment of Relevant History) Regulations 2014, the Chief Executive of the Department for Communities and Social Inclusion (DCSI) declares that the DCSI Screening Unit is an authorised screening unit for the purposes of undertaking relevant history assessments under the Disability Services Act 1993.

## FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 2007: SECTION 115

TAKE notice that pursuant to Section 115 of the Fisheries Management Act 2007, Michael Veenstra of Belluna Pty Ltd (trading as Spirit of the Coorong Cruises) (the 'exemption holder') or employees acting as his agent, are exempt from the closure notice made under Section 79 of the Fisheries Management Act 2007, published in the *South Australian Government Gazette* on 31 October 2013, referring to the closure of the Pipi Fishery—Coorong Beach, but only insofar as the exemption holder may take Pipi in order to demonstrate the collection of Pipi to customers on

the Spirit of the Coorong Cruises, from the waters described in Schedule 1, (the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 2 of this notice, from 17 April 2014 until 31 March 2015, unless varied or revoked earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

The Younghusband Peninsula between the Murray Mouth and 28 mile crossing.

SCHEDULE 2

1. The Pipi collected by the exemption holder and his agents are for demonstration purposes only and must not be sold.

2. A maximum of 10 Pipi's per person may be taken for demonstration purposes and may be consumed on the beach during the cruise. Any Pipi not consumed must be immediately returned to the water where taken. No Pipi's may be returned to the boat.

3. The exemption holder must not permit the consumption of Pipi during a South Australian Shellfish Quality Assurance Program closure.

4. The exemption holder or agent must notify PIRSA Fishwatch on 1800 065 522 at least two hours prior to conducting the exempted activity and answer a series of questions about the exempted activity. The exemption holder or agent will need to have a copy of the exemption notice at the time of making the call, and be able to provide information about the area and time of the exempted activity, the vehicles and boats involved, the number of agents undertaking the exempted activity and other related questions. Exemption No. ME9902684.

5. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder and his agent must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a Fisheries Officer if requested.

6. The exemption holder and agent must not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Management Act 2007 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

7. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder and his agents must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a Fisheries Officer if requested.

FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 2007: SECTION 79

TAKE note that the notice made under Section 79 of the Fisheries Management Act 2007, dated 7 January 2014, and published in the *South Australian Government Gazette*, dated 9 January 2014, on

page 5, being the second notice on that page, referring to the West Coast Prawn Fishery, is hereby varied such that it will not be unlawful for a person fishing pursuant to a West Coast Prawn Fishery Licence to use prawn trawl nets in the waters specified in Schedule 1, under the conditions specified in Schedule 2, during the period specified in Schedule 3.

SCHEDULE 1

The waters of the West Coast Prawn Fishery adjacent to Coffin Bay, Ceduna and Venus Bay.

SCHEDULE 2

1. Each licence holder must ensure that a representative sample of the catch (a 'bucket count') is taken at least three times per night during the fishing activity.

2. Each 'bucket count' sample must be accurately weighed to 7 kg where possible and the total number of prawns contained in the bucket must be recorded on the daily catch and effort return.

3. Fishing must cease if one of the following limits is reached:

- (a) A total of 14 nights of fishing are completed;
- (b) The average catch per vessel, per night (for all three vessels) drops below 300 kg for two consecutive nights;
- (c) The average prawn 'bucket count' for all three vessels exceeds 240 prawns per bucket on any single fishing night in the Coffin Bay area; or
- (d) The average prawn 'bucket count' for all three vessels exceeds 250 prawns per bucket on any single fishing night in the Venus Bay area; or
- (e) The average prawn 'bucket count' for all three vessels exceeds 270 prawns per bucket on any single fishing night in the Ceduna area.

4. The fleet must nominate a licence holder to provide a daily update by telephone or SMS message to the PIRSA Fisheries Manager, to report the average prawn catch per vessel and the average prawn 'bucket count' information.

5. No fishing activity may be undertaken between the prescribed times of sunrise and sunset for Adelaide (as published in the *South Australian Government Gazette* pursuant to the requirements of the Proof of Sunrise and Sunset Act 1923) during the period specified in Schedule 3.

SCHEDULE 3

Commence at sunset on 22 April 2014 and end at sunrise on 7 May 2014.
