## **Administrative Arrangements (State Election) Proclamation 2026**

under sections 5, 7 and 8 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1994*

### **1—Short title**

This proclamation may be cited as the *Administrative Arrangements (State Election) Proclamation 2026*.

### **2—Commencement**

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

### **3—Committal of Acts**

The administration of an Act referred to in Schedule 1 is committed to the Minister whose title appears at the head of the list in which the Act appears.

### **4—Dissolution of bodies corporate**

The bodies corporate referred to in Schedule 2 are dissolved.

### **5—Constitution of certain Ministers as bodies corporate**

The Ministers referred to in Schedule 3 are constituted as bodies corporate.

### **6—Vesting of certain assets, rights and liabilities**

- (1) The assets, rights and liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Emergency Services and Correctional Services are vested in and attached to the Minister for Correctional Services and the Minister for Emergency Services according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that assets, rights and liabilities appropriate to particular responsibilities or functions vest in, or attach to, the appropriate body corporate.
- (2) The assets, rights and liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Industrial Relations and Public Sector are vested in and attached to the Minister for Industrial Relations and the Minister for Public Sector according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that assets, rights and liabilities appropriate to particular responsibilities or functions vest in, or attach to, the appropriate body corporate.
- (3) The assets, rights and liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science are vested in and attached to the Minister for State Development.
- (4) The assets, rights and liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Trade and Investment are vested in and attached to the Minister for State Development.

## 7—Interpretative provisions

- (1) A reference to the Minister for Emergency Services and Correctional Services in an Act or a statutory instrument under an Act will, if the Act was, on the day immediately before the effective date, committed to the administration of that Minister, have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the administration of the Act is for the time being committed.
- (2) A reference to the Minister for Emergency Services and Correctional Services in a statutory instrument or any other kind of instrument, or a contract, agreement or other document, made or entered into before the effective date (other than a reference to which subclause (1) is applicable) will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister for Correctional Services or the Minister for Emergency Services according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that the reference will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the relevant responsibilities or functions are currently assigned.
- (3) A reference to the Minister for Industrial Relations and Public Sector in an Act or a statutory instrument under an Act will, if the Act was, on the day immediately before the effective date, committed to the administration of that Minister, have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the administration of the Act is for the time being committed.
- (4) A reference to the Minister for Industrial Relations and Public Sector in a statutory instrument or any other kind of instrument, or a contract, agreement or other document, made or entered into before the effective date (other than a reference to which subclause (3) is applicable) will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister for Industrial Relations or the Minister for Public Sector according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that the reference will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the relevant responsibilities or functions are currently assigned.
- (5) A reference to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science in an Act, a statutory instrument or any other kind of instrument or a contract, agreement or other document made or entered into before the day on which this proclamation is made will have effect as if it were reference to the Minister for State Development.
- (6) A reference to the Minister for Trade and Investment in an Act, a statutory instrument or any other kind of instrument or a contract, agreement or other document made or entered into before the day on which this proclamation is made will have effect as if it were reference to the Minister for State Development.
- (7) In this clause—  
*effective date* means the date on which this proclamation is made.

### 2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

For each administrative unit listed in column 1 of the table in Schedule 1, the Minister listed in column 2 opposite the reference to the administrative unit is designated as the administrative unit's Minister with responsibility for the unit.
