FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Water Ecoscience Pty Ltd (hereinafter referred to as the 'permit holder'), 68 Ricketts Road, Mount Waverley, Vic. 3149 is exempt from the Fisheries Act 1982, in that the permit holder shall not be guilty of an offence when using electrofishing gear in the waters described in Schedule 1 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2, from 8 February 1999 until 11 February 1999.

SCHEDULE 1

All waters (including a section of the River Torrens) located on the property owned by W. I. and R. J. Meyers, folio 67, certificate of title volume 3957, part sections 1301, 1302, 1305, 1306 and 1632.

SCHEDULE 2

1. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity the permit holder must have in his possession a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer.

2. All fish taken pursuant to this notice must be released into the waters from which they were taken.

3. The permit holder must notify the PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 at least 24 hours prior to engaging in the permitted activity and provide the following information:

- the name of the persons conducting the permitted activity;
- the proposed time and date of conducting the permitted activity; and
- the intended area of conducting the permitted activity.

4. The permit holder must comply with all safety requirements as detailed in the Australian National Guidelines for Electrofishing.

5. The permit holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under the Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, those holders of a southern zone rock lobster fishery licence issued pursuant to the Scheme of Management (Rock Lobster Fisheries) Regulations 1991 (hereinafter referred to as the 'fishers') are exempt from the provisions of licence condition No. 225, insofar as they may take southern rock lobster using a boat that (a) has been used to take southern rock lobster from outside State waters since last leaving port, or (b) is carrying southern rock lobster taken from outside State waters, subject to the conditions specified in the schedule, from 4 February 1999 to 31 May 1999.

THE SCHEDULE

The fishers shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
