FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 23

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 23 of the Fisheries Act 1982, I, Gary Raymond Morgan, Director of Fisheries hereby:

1. Revoke any previous delegations of my powers under sections 49 and 50 of the Fisheries Act 1982.
2. Delegate to the person for the time being holding or acting in the position of General Manager, Aquaculture of the Department of Primary Industries and Resources, my powers under sections 49 and 50 of the Fisheries Act 1982.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Jim Puckridge of The University of Adelaide, Department of Environmental Biology, Adelaide, S.A. 5005 or persons acting as his agents (hereinafter referred to as the 'permit holder'), is exempt from the provisions of the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the permit holder may engage in the activities specified in Schedule 1 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity'), using the gear specified in Schedule 2, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 3 from 1 January 2000 until 1 April 2002.

SCHEDULE 1

The collection of native and introduced fish, including those species protected, pursuant to section 42 of the Fisheries Act 1982, from the waters of the Diamantina Creek, Dawsley Creek and the Bremer River.

SCHEDULE 2

One seine net, maximum length 2 m, minimum mesh 3 mm; 10 fish traps, maximum dimension 1 m, maximum entrance size 10 cm; one dab net per person.

SCHEDULE 3

1. All fish collected pursuant to this notice not required for scientific evaluation must be returned to the water on completion of the study.

2. The fisher shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

3. While engaging in the permitted activity, the permit holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer, if such an officer requests that it be produced.

4. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the permit holder must advise the PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.
