FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that, pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Sylvan Park Aquaculture Pty Ltd or their agents (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') 49 Abbott Avenue, McLaren Vale, S.A. 5171 are exempt from the Fisheries Act 1982, insofar as they may take King George Whiting (*Sillaginodes punctata*) for the purpose of aquaculture broodstock subject to the conditions in Schedule 1 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity').

SCHEDULE 1

1. The exemption holder may take a maximum of 100 King George Whiting (*Sillaginodes punctata*). All King George Whiting taken pursuant to this notice may not be sold or transferred to another party.

2. The exemption holder may engage in the permitted activity from the date of gazettal of this notice until 31 December 2000.

3. The fish can only be caught using recreational line and must be in accordance with recreational size limits.

4. The exemption holder shall notify PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture on 1800 065 522 at least 24 hours prior to conducting the permitted activity with details on the proposed location and duration of the trip.

5. The exemption holder must, within 50 m of the point of landing of any King George Whiting taken pursuant to this notice, complete the PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture form

Broodstock Collection Statement. Immediately upon arrival at the exemption holder's registered aquaculture site, this form must be faxed to PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture on (08) 8226 2320. Upon release into the registered aquaculture site, all King George Whiting taken pursuant to this notice must be held separately so as to be clearly identified as wild broodstock.

6. The exemption holder shall record the number of wild broodstock held pursuant to this notice in a register to be maintained at the registered aquaculture site, which must be made available for inspection by a Fisheries Compliance Officer upon request.

7. PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture retains the right for a departmental officer to accompany the exemption holder at any time during the permitted activity.

8. While engaged in the permitted activity the exemption holder shall carry or have about or near his person a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer upon request.

9. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
