## FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Kenneth J. Mathison (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), P.O. Box 187, Robe, S.A. 5276, is exempt from licence condition number 206, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, in that the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when taking giant crabs (*Pseudocarcinus gigas*) during the closed northern rock lobster fishery, pursuant to Miscellaneous Fishery Licence Number Y073 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity').

## SCHEDULE 1

1. This exemption is valid from the date of gazettal of this notice until 2400 hours on 2 June 2000.
2. All fishing operations conducted pursuant to this notice must be conducted pursuant to Miscellaneous Fishery Licence Number Y073.
3. The exemption holder must notify the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit one hour prior to landing giant crabs (*Pseudocarcinus gigas*) taken pursuant to this notice and provide the name of the registered processor to whom the giant crabs (*Pseudocarcinus gigas*) will be delivered and the estimated weight of the catch.
4. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity the exemption holder must have in his possession a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if requested by a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer.
5. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

## FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Steven, W. Clarke (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), P.O.
