FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Jode Atterton (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), 24 Flaxman Street, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5606 is exempt from sections 34 and 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as he may take beche-de-mer (*Holothuriidae* spp. and *Stichopodidae* spp.) and turbo (*Subnivalia undulatis*) for the purposes of trade or business (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions in Schedule 1, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2001.

SCHEDULE 1

1. Fish may be taken from all waters of the State west of 138°E excluding the waters of Streaky Bay.
2. The exemption holder may take fish by diving and collection by hand.
3. The exemption holder may take no more than 500 kilograms of beche-de-mer and 500 kilograms of turbo in any one week.
4. The exemption holder must provide the Director of Fisheries separate statistical catch and effort information, in the form of a daily log as provided.

5. The exemption holder shall notify the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 prior to conducting the exempted activity with the following information:

- details of the boat that will be used to engage in the exempted activity;
- the intended area of conducting the exempted activity; and
- the intended place and time of launching and retrieval of the nominated boat for that day.

6. PIRSA Fisheries retains the right for a Departmental Officer to accompany the exemption holder at any time during fishing operations.

7. While engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder shall carry or have about or near his person a copy of this notice and must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer upon request.

8. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
