FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, David G. Ayres (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), P.O. Box 366, Victor Harbor, S.A. 5211, holder of Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M206, is exempt from the provisions of Regulation 9 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 2000 but only insofar as the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when using up to a maximum of 1 000 octopus traps for the purpose of trade and business pursuant to Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M206 (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1 from the date of this notice until 30 June 2003, unless varied or revoked earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

1. Octopus pots must be marked with a white buoy which complies with the regulations, and bear a 50 mm red stripe around its circumference, so as to be visible above the water.
2. Octopus pots must not be baited and must not have doors.
3. A monthly catch and effort return for octopus must be completed and sent to the South Australian Research and Development Institute (SARDI) within 15 days of the end of each month for which the return is completed.
4. Whilst engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder must have in his possession a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer.
5. The exemption holder must not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act except where specifically exempted by this notice.
