**FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59**

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Jason VanLaarhoven of the Department for Water, Land and Biodiversity Conservation, G.P.O. Box 2834, Adelaide, S.A. 5001 or persons acting as his agents (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') is exempt from the provisions of the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the exemption holder may engage in the collection of native and introduced fish, including those species protected pursuant to section 42 of the Fisheries Act 1982, from the waters of the River Torrens (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), using the gear specified in Schedule 1, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2 on 4 June 2002.

**SCHEDULE 1**

- 1 seine net with minimum mesh size 6 mm
- 1 dip net per person
- 20 fish traps

**SCHEDULE 2**

1. All native fish collected pursuant to this notice must be returned to the water on completion of the evaluation.
2. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must advise the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.
3. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
4. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
