No. 7 of 2004—Australian Crime Commission (South Australia) Act 2004. An Act to make provision for the operation of the Australian Crime Commission in South Australia; to repeal the National Crime Authority (State Provisions) Act 1984; to make related amendments to other Acts; and for other purposes.

No. 8 of 2004—Genetically Modified Crops Management Act 2004. An Act to provide for the designation of areas of the State for the purposes of preserving for marketing purposes the identity of certain food crops according to whether they are genetically modified crops or non-genetically modified crops; to provide for the segregation of genetically modified food crops and their products in appropriate cases; to provide for associated regulatory powers; to provide certain protections with respect to the spread of genetically modified plant material; and for other purposes.

Section 4 (1) (b)

Notice of Approval of Contingencies

NO. 2 OF 2004

INDEPENDENT GAMBLING AUTHORITY, by this notice, approves contingencies relating to sporting or other events within Australia:

1. Citation

This notice may be cited as the Approved Contingencies (Roxby Downs Picnic Racing) Notice 2004.

2. Approval

- (1) The contingencies listed in the table are approved in respect of fixed odds betting by licensed bookmakers.
- (2) This approval is subject to the provisions of the Authorised Betting Operations Act 2000 ('the Act'), the Bookmakers Licensing Rules 2000, any other rules made under section 62 of the Act, and the conditions to which a licence or permit are subject.

- (3) This approval of contingencies may be amended or revoked by further notice.

3. Definitions

In this notice:

'Event':

(a) means a race on the flat for:

- (i) horses; or
(ii) camels,

where each animal is ridden by a person.

(b) includes, in relation to an event mentioned in paragraph (a) for which there were more accepters than places, a division of that event offering the same prize as the event.

'Place' means the contingency that a specified Entrant will place either first, second or third (or, if applicable, fourth) in a specified Event (including where different odds are offered by a bookmaker for first place *vis-a-vis* any of second, third or, if applicable, fourth place).

'Race', with respect to horses, includes:

- (a) a race conducted by a licensed racing club; and
(b) a race at a picnic race meeting or a gymkhana.

'Win' means the contingency that a specified Entrant will place first in or win a specified Event.

- (1) This notice may be cited as the Approved Contingencies (Highest Season Finish) Notice 2004.
- (2) This notice amends the notice dated 11 December 2001, published in the *Government Gazette* on 13 December 2001 at page 5549, in this notice called 'the Principal Notice'.

2. Insertion of 'Highest Season Finish' contingency

- (1) In Item 1 of the Table in Part 2 of the Principal Notice, after the expression 'Total Match Points*' in the column titled 'Approved Contingencies', insert:

- (1) This notice may be cited as the Approved Contingencies (Additional Fixed Odds Contingencies) Notice 2004.
- (2) This notice amends the notice dated 11 December 2001, published in the *Government Gazette* on 13 December 2001 at page 5549, in this notice called 'the Principal Notice'.

2. Insertion of additional contingencies—all approved sports

- (1) In Item 1 of the Table in Part 2 of the Principal Notice, after the expression 'Total Match Points*' in the column titled 'Approved Contingencies', insert:
'Entrant Out-Win*, Entrant Out-Place*, Dally M Medal*, Pick 6*, Top Aussie Finish*, Top Overseas Finish*, Top 5*, Relegation*.'
- (2) In Item 2 of the Table in Part 2 of the Principal Notice, after the expression 'Coleman Medal' in the column titled 'Approved Contingencies', insert:
'Michael Tuck Medal'.

- (3) In Item 4 of the Table in Part 2 of the Principal Notice, after the expression 'Group Betting' in the column titled 'Approved Contingencies', insert:
' , Make the Cut'.
- (4) In Item 5 of the Table in Part 2 of the Principal Notice, after the expression 'Most Wickets' in the column titled 'Approved Contingencies', insert:
' , Century'.
- (5) Insert, in the appropriate alphabetical sequence in the Principal Notice, each of the following definitions:
- 'Century' means the contingency that a specified cricket team's cumulative score will reach 100 runs in a specified innings or at a specified time or within a specified period.
- 'Dally M Medal' means the contingency that a specified player in the National Rugby League competition will win the League's Dally M Medal for best and fairest on the ground.
- 'Entrant Out-Win' means the contingency that a specified Entrant will place first in or win in a specified Event on the basis that one or more other Entrants will be regarded as not having run, competed or otherwise participated in the Event.
- 'Entrant Out-Place' means the contingency that a specified Entrant will place either first, second or third (or, if applicable, fourth) in a specified Event on the basis that one or more other Entrants will be regarded as not having run, competed or otherwise participated in the Event.
- 'Make the Cut' means the contingency that a specified Entrant(s) in a golf Event will make the cut in that Event.
- 'Michael Tuck Medal' means the contingency that a specified player will win the Michael Tuck Medal for best on ground in the Australian Football League pre-season competition.
- 'Pick 6' means the contingency that a combination of six specified Entrants in six specified Events will each place first in or win, or will win by a specified amount, range or margin (including where a specified Entrant may be given a notional start point or handicap), in the respective Entrant's Event.
- 'Relegation' means the contingency that a specified team or teams will be demoted at the end of a specified season from a division within a competition.

'Top Aussie Finish' means the contingency that a specified Entrant, identified by the licensee to be Australian, will place above all other specified Entrants, identified by the licensee to be Australians, in a specified Event.

'Top Overseas Finish' means the contingency that a specified Entrant, identified by the licensee to be an overseas Entrant, will place above all other specified Entrants, identified by the licensee to be overseas Entrants, in a specified Event.

'Top 5' means the contingency that a specified Entrant in an Event being a competition (with more than five Entrants) will finish the event ranked no worse than fifth.

Approval of Category A Containers:

Approve as Category A Containers, as identified in column 5 of the Schedule, subject to the conditions in subclauses (i) and (ii) below, each of the classes of containers identified by reference to the following matters described in the first 4 columns of Schedule 1 of this Notice which are sold in South Australia:

- (a) the product which each class of containers shall contain;
- (b) the size of the containers;
- (c) the type of containers;
- (d) the name of the holders of these approvals.

(i) *Subsection 69 (3) Arrangements:*

The holders of these approvals must ensure that the empty containers which belong to their respective class of containers hereby approved as Category A Containers are collected from the retailers that sell them, and recycled in an appropriate manner. Disposal at landfill is not considered an appropriate method of disposal.

(ii) *Approved Refund Markings:*

- (a) The holders of these approvals must ensure that each container which belongs to their respective class of containers hereby approved as Category A Containers bears the refund marking approved by the Authority in respect of that class of containers.
- (b) The refund marking that appears on each container that belongs to the class of containers hereby approved, must be a minimum 1.5 mm for the smallest letter in the statement and a minimum 3 mm for the numeric ('5') in the statement.

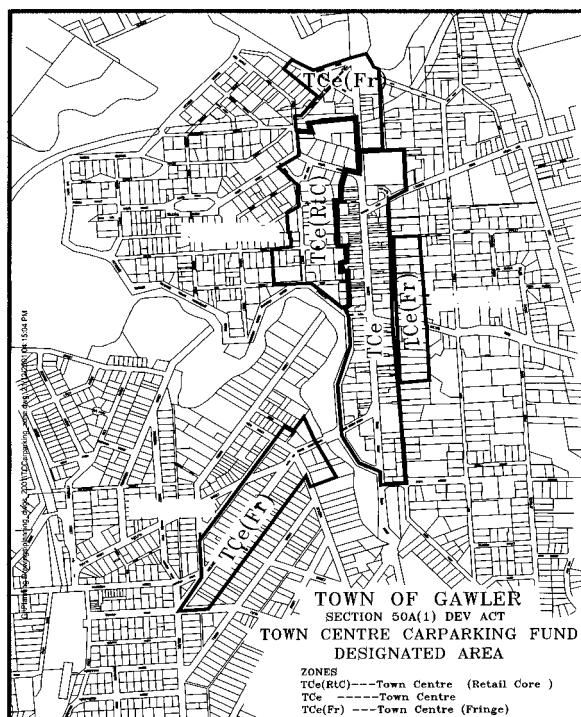

DISTRICT COUNCIL OF YORKE PENINSULA

By-Law No. K—Boat Ramps

TO regulate the use of Boat Ramps within the Council area and surrounding lands used for access to the Boat Ramps and which are under the control of the Council.

Definitions

1. In this by-law:

- (1) 'Annual Ticket' means a ticket purchased from the Council Offices authorising the launch of one small craft at a Boat Ramp and is valid until the next 30 June.

- (2) 'Boat Ramp' means a facility constructed maintained and operated by the Council for the launching of small craft.
- (3) 'Council Offices' means the offices of the Council located at 8 Elizabeth Street, Maitland; 15 Edithburgh Road, Yorketown; 18 Main Street, Minlaton and Player Street, Warooka in the State of South Australia.
- (4) 'Short Term Ticket' means a ticket purchased from a vending machine located at the Boat Ramp, valid for one launch of any one small craft at the Boat Ramp within 24 hours from the time of purchase.
- (5) 'Officer' means a Council Officer, Police Officer or any other authorised person.
- (6) 'Ticket' means either an Annual Ticket or a Short Term Ticket.

Boat Ramp Usage

2. No person shall use a Boat Ramp without having first purchased a Ticket.
3. Council shall from time to time prescribe a fee for a Ticket to use a Boat Ramp.
4. An Annual Ticket may be purchased for a fee from any one of the Council Offices.
5. A Short Term Ticket may be purchased from the vending machine(s) located at or near a Boat Ramp.
6. Council may erect signs or notices stating the fee and the location of the ticket vending machine(s).
7. Upon the request of an Officer, any person about to use, using, or having used, a Boat Ramp may be asked to produce a Ticket.
8. Council may exempt organisations involved in search and rescue at sea from the requirement to purchase a Ticket.

Offence

9. Any person using a Boat Ramp without having first obtained a Ticket commits an offence.
10. If a Ticket cannot be produced, the Officer may issue an account to the person using a Boat Ramp.
