CTP INSURANCE PREMIUM SCHEDULE Effective 1 August 2015

Where a vehicle is within more than one category the premium shall be that fixed by the category deemed by the insurer to be the appropriate category for that vehicle. Where the Act (1) provides for a vehicle to be registered and insured for a term beyond 12 months, a premium calculated in proportion to the 12 monthly premium applies. *All premiums are inclusive of GST.
