- 1 Section 5 of the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (South Australia) Act 2013* provides that if—

 - the Governor is satisfied that an amendment that corresponds, or substantially corresponds, to the amendment made by the Parliament of Queensland should be made to the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (South Australia)*,

- 2 The Parliament of Queensland has enacted the *Heavy Vehicle National Law and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2019* to, among other things, amend the Queensland Act and the Governor is satisfied that the amendments corresponding to the Queensland amendments set out in Part 2 of these regulations should be made to the South Australian Heavy Vehicle National Law text.

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (South Australia) (Amendment of Law) Regulations 2020*.

2—Commencement

- Subject to this regulation, these regulations come into operation on the day on which section 7 of the *Heavy Vehicle National Law and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2019* of Queensland comes into operation.
- Part 2 Division 1 comes into operation on the day on which section 15 of the *Road Vehicle Standards Act 2018* of the Commonwealth comes into operation.

3—Interpretation

identification plate means a plate approved to be placed on a vehicle, or taken to have been placed on a vehicle, under the *Motor Vehicle Standards Act 1989*;

- (3) Section 5—after the definition of *motor vehicle* insert:

Motor Vehicle Standards Act 1989 means the repealed *Motor Vehicle Standards Act 1989* of the Commonwealth as in force before its repeal;

- (4) Section 5—after the definition of *road transport* insert:

Road Vehicle Standards Act 2018 means the *Road Vehicle Standards Act 2018* of the Commonwealth;

Exemption Notice 3 - BA/EN3/20

PURSUANT to section 6(2)(a)(iii) of the *Genetically Modified Crops Management Act 2004* ("the Act"), I, Dan van Holst Pellekaan, Acting Minister for Primary Industries and Regional Development, confer the following Exemption on BASF Australia Ltd (ABN 62 008 437 867 and ACN 008 437 867) ("BASF Australia Ltd") for the purpose of transporting genetically modified canola seed [*Brassica napus*] through designated areas of South Australia, subject to the conditions specified herein.

This exemption remains in force until varied or revoked.

For the purpose of this Notice, I nominate the following person as the Nominated Officer within Primary Industries and Regions South Australia to whom all communication should be directed:

See section 3 for the definitions of terms.

SECTION 1: GENERAL CONDITIONS

BASF Australia Ltd, its employees, agents and other representatives must comply with these conditions. BASF Australia Ltd must take responsibility for the actions or inactions of their employees, agents and other representatives arising under the Activities.

1. Notification of Responsible Person

- 1.1. BASF Australia Ltd must inform the Nominated Officer in writing of the contact details of the person within the company who is responsible for the transportation of the genetically modified canola seeds through South Australia before the seeds enter South Australia for the first time.
- 1.2. No later than one business day prior to each occasion of the genetically modified canola seed entering South Australia, BASF Australia Ltd must inform the Nominated Officer in writing of the transportation company name and the transport licence plate number(s) of the vehicle or trailer being used to carry the seed.
- 1.3. BASF Australia Ltd must immediately notify the Nominated Officer in writing if any of the information provided for the above has changed.

2. Informing people of their obligations

- 2.1. BASF Australia Ltd must inform each person covered by these conditions of the obligations imposed on them by these conditions.
- 2.2. BASF Australia Ltd must provide the Nominated Officer, on the Nominated Officer's written request, a signed statement from each person covered by these conditions that BASF Australia Ltd has informed the person of the conditions applying to that person.

3. Material Changes in circumstances

- 3.1. BASF Australia Ltd must immediately, by notice in writing, inform the Nominated Officer of any event or circumstances occurring after the commencement of these conditions that would affect the capacity of BASF Australia Ltd to meet the conditions in this exemption.

SECTION 2: SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

1. Transportation of the genetically modified canola seed through South Australia.

- 1.1. The genetically modified canola seed must be packed in a sealed unbreakable primary container.

- 1.2. Every primary container must be clearly marked 'BA/EN3/20 – Canola Seed'.
 - 1.3. Every primary container must be packed in a sealed unbreakable secondary container.
 - 1.4. Every secondary container used to transport the genetically modified canola seed must be labelled:
 - 1.4.1. to indicate that it contains genetically modified canola seed; and
 - 1.4.2. with telephone contact numbers for BASF Australia Ltd, including instructions to contact BASF Australia Ltd in the event that the container is broken and/or misdirected.
 - 1.5. Each secondary container must remain sealed during transit.
- 2. Compliance Management Plan**
- 2.1. Within 14 days prior to genetically modified canola seed entering South Australia for the first time, BASF Australia Ltd must submit a written Compliance Management Plan to the Nominated Officer.
 - 2.2. The Compliance Management Plan must include a clear methodology that details how BASF Australia Ltd will:
 - 2.2.1. ensure compliance with these conditions and document that compliance;
 - 2.2.2. manage the transportation of the genetically modified canola seed;
 - 2.2.3. ensure the amount of the genetically modified canola seed entering South Australia equals the amount leaving South Australia; and
 - 2.2.4. facilitate the Nominated Officer (or his or her delegate) to audit or monitor the transportation of the genetically modified canola seed.
 - 2.3. BASF Australia Ltd must immediately notify the Nominated Officer in writing if there is any change to the Compliance Management Plan
- 3. Contingency Plan**
- 3.1. Within 14 days prior to the genetically modified canola seed entering South Australia for the first time, BASF Australia Ltd must submit a written Contingency Management Plan to the Nominated Officer detailing measures to be taken in the event that a secondary container is broken.
 - 3.2. The Contingency Management Plan must include details of procedures to:
 - 3.2.1. ensure the Nominated Officer is notified immediately when BASF Australia Ltd becomes aware of the event;
 - 3.2.2. destroy the genetically modified canola seed or render them non-viable; and
 - 3.2.3. monitor and destroy any Volunteer plants existing as a result of the event.
 - 3.3. BASF Australia Ltd must immediately notify the Nominated Officer in writing if there is any change to the Contingency Plan.

SECTION 3: INTERPRETATION AND DEFINITIONS

Words and phrases used in this Exemption have the same meanings as they do in the *Genetically Modified Crops Management Act 2004* (SA), the *Gene Technology Act 2000* (Commonwealth) and the *Gene Technology Regulations 2001* (Commonwealth).

Words importing a gender include any other gender.

Words in the singular include the plural and words in the plural include the singular.

Words importing persons include a partnership and a body, whether corporate or otherwise.

References to any statute or other legislation (whether primary or subordinate) is to a statute or other legislation of the Commonwealth of Australia as amended or replaced from time to time unless the contrary intention appears.

Where any word or phrase is given a defined meaning, any other part of speech or other grammatical form in respect of that word or phrase has a corresponding meaning.

In this Exemption:

- 1.1. 'Canola' means plants of the species *Brassica napus*.
- 1.2. 'Destroy' means killed by one or more of the following methods:
 - 1.2.1. stalk pulling; or
 - 1.2.2. light tillage; or
 - 1.2.3. burning; or
 - 1.2.4. treatment with herbicide; or
 - 1.2.5. slashing; or
 - 1.2.6. mowing; or
 - 1.2.7. hand weeding; or
 - 1.2.8. burial under 1 metre of soil; or
 - 1.2.9. grazing; or
 - 1.2.10. a combination of the above.
- 1.3. 'Volunteer plants' means progeny of the genetically modified canola seed.

under the *Motor Vehicles Act 1959*

1—Short title

This notice may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Conditional Registration—Recognition of Motor Vehicle Clubs) Notice 2020 - South Australian Supra Club Incorporated

2—Commencement

This notice takes effect from the date it is published in the Gazette.

3—Interpretation

In this notice—

Act means the *Motor Vehicles Act 1959*;

Code of Practice means the ‘Code of Practice for Club Registration - a 90 day conditional registration scheme for historic, left hand drive and street rod vehicles’ published by the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure;

Conditional Registration Scheme or *Scheme* means the scheme for conditional registration of historic, prescribed left hand drive and street rod motor vehicles under section 25 of the Act and regulations 15 and 16 of the Motor Vehicles Regulations 2010;

Department means the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure

Federation means the Federation of Historic Motoring Clubs Inc;

MR334 form means an ‘Approval for Registration of Vehicle on the Club Registration Scheme (MR334)’;

Prescribed log book means a log book in a form approved by the Registrar;

Registrar means the Registrar of Motor Vehicles;

Regulations means the Motor Vehicles Regulations 2010.

4—Recognition of motor vehicle clubs

The motor vehicle clubs specified in Schedule 1 are, subject to the conditions set out in clause 5, recognised for the purposes of regulation 16 of the Regulations.

5—Conditions of recognition

A motor vehicle club specified in Schedule 1 must comply with the following conditions:

- (a) the club must maintain a constitution approved by the Registrar;
- (b) the club must nominate and have members authorised by the Registrar (authorised persons). The club’s authorised person(s) are responsible for approving applicants and motor vehicles for registration under the Scheme. This includes confirming that Scheme applicants are financial members of a club; any other details as required by the Registrar on the MR334 form; and to inspect members’ vehicles when requested to do so by the Registrar;
- (c) the club must issue a prescribed log book to club members for each of their vehicles to record vehicle use;
- (d) the club must cancel a member’s prescribed log book when a member resigns, must ensure that a statutory declaration is provided when a member’s log book is lost or destroyed, must keep details of members’ prescribed log book return sheets and forward copies of the same to the Registrar or Federation annually as required;

- (e) the club must create and maintain records detailing all its financial members, its authorised persons, all vehicles for which an MR334 form has been issued, all statutory declarations received and prescribed log books issued and returned to the club;
- (f) the club must keep records for a period of 5 years from the date of the document and these records must include all duplicate MR334 forms, all records of motor vehicle inspections undertaken in accordance with paragraph (b), all statutory declarations provided by members for the purposes of paragraphs (d), all prescribed log books issued by reference to their serial number, the member's name and the vehicle for which it was issued, and to make all such records available for inspection or provide copies of the records at the request of the Registrar for audit purposes;
- (g) the club must ensure, as far as practicable, that all members comply with the Code of Practice;
- (h) the club, as far as practicable, must report to the Registrar or the Federation details of members and motor vehicles not complying with the conditions and criteria set out in the Code of Practice for the Scheme;
- (i) the club must provide to the Registrar, within 2 months after the end of the club's financial year, an annual report detailing members from that financial year with vehicles registered under the Scheme who are no longer financial members of the club;
- (j) the club must notify the Registrar, in writing, within 14 days of resolution to cease operation as a club and must provide the club records specified in paragraph (f) to the Registrar within 14 days of its dissolution.

Note—

Under regulation 16(3)(c) of the *Motor Vehicles Regulations 2010*, the Registrar may, by notice in the Gazette, withdraw the recognition of a motor vehicle club if satisfied that the club has contravened or failed to comply with a condition applying to its recognition by the Registrar, or if there is other good cause to withdraw the recognition.
