Controlled Substances (Poisons) (Emergency Supply – Human Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)) Notice 2020

under regulation 21 of the Controlled Substances (Poisons) Regulations 2011

1—Short title

This notice may be cited as the *Controlled Substances (Poisons) (Emergency Supply – Human Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)) Notice 2020.*

2—Commencement

This notice comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Declaration of emergency and period

For the purposes of regulation 21(2)(f)(ii)(A) of the *Controlled Substances (Poisons) Regulations 2011* I specify:

- (a) the emergency consisting of the major emergency declared by the State Coordinator for the State of South Australia on 22 March 2020 at 13:00 hours pursuant to section 23(1) of the *Emergency Management Act 2004* in relation to the outbreak of the Human Disease named COVID-19 within South Australia; and
- (b) the period of time that the declaration of a major emergency referred to in (a) remains in force under the *Emergency Management Act 2004*.
